v1.3.002 - Released 17th April 2012

- “Print Worksheet” function. Several users suggested they would tend to work on their batches in a prep area, where a PC may not be available. Therefore a worksheet would be ideal to note down details such as SG, items added, test results etc. The sheet can be completed in the prep area and then the details keyed into BrewTrax at a later date. We hope to further improve this function in later versions, where it will print items from the calendar/to-do-list. The Print Worksheet option is on the main ribbon bar, under the “Labels & Reports” section. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- “Print Carboy Tag” function added. When in the “My Brews” module, you can now select a brew/batch and print a carboy tag. This “tag” will print the essential details about the brew onto A4 paper and provide a cut-out section to place the tag over the neck of the carboy. The initial release of this function will print details on the tag such as name of brew of recipe, start date, finish date, start SG, items added and space for hand-written notes. We welcome feedback on this template and will add a variety of additional carboy tag templates to the next release. You will find the carboy tag option on the left navigation panel, when selecting a brew. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- New “Help - About” option. When logging support calls and questions you can now easily view your registration details from the new “Help - About” function. You can also click the link on this new screen to go straight to our website. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Increased flexibility to change the “look and feel” of BrewTrax. We have received feedback that many users are running BrewTrax on laptops/notebooks with smaller screens and sometimes struggle to view the whole BrewTrax screen. This release adds an option to resize the left navigation panel in all modules and also remove the icons from the tabs at the top of the page. This is managed from the Settings area. We have also reduced the font size on the tabs to help further. Upon testing this, we have noted other areas where the screen space can improved and will continue to enhance support for smaller screens. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Ability to add photos in the “My Brews” module. We already support linking of photos to Brew Kits, but we have received feedback that you would like to take photos of the brewing process and add them into BrewTrax. This feature has now been added. You can select a photo and add a title and date to it. When you view the batch in “My Brews” you can now view any photos you have taken in date order. The photos can be of anything of course! The location you collected your fruits, fermentation, the prep area.... anything you like! There is no limit to the number of photos you can add. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- After receiving a number of support calls that users had “lost” some of their brews in the BrewTrax database, we narrowed this down to users applying a filtered view to their brew list. The data was quite safe! For example, you may have set BrewTrax to only display Red Wine batches, rather than Red and White wine. It was not obvious enough that a filter has been enabled and saved. We have enhanced this feature so that it is now very obvious when a filter has been enabled. [\[Enhancement\]](#)
- A small fix has been made to the “Test Results” area, where the Total So2 was not showing with the correct orientation, depending on your display settings. This has now been resolved. [\[Fixed\]](#)

- Adding a brew batch from the “My Cellar” module has been removed, after feedback from users that it was causing confusion with the Bottling Wizard in “My Brews” (which is in fact the same function). [\[Modified Feature\]](#)
- When printing your brew details (“Print Brew” function) the notes that were recorded against the custom fields are now included in the printout. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Resolved an issue with the brew variety functionality. The variety of wine could not be amended after setting it's initial type. [\[Fixed\]](#)

- Scheduler now fully integrates with "My Brews" module. You can now create appointments & reminders simply by selecting a brew and adding a reminder/scheduled event. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Scheduler now fully integrates with "My Cellar" module. You can now create appointments & reminders simply by selecting a cellar batch and adding a reminder/schedule event. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Test results area now allows you to capture brew temperature, Brix, free So2 & total So2 (in addition to the existing test results for SG, TA and PH). [\[New Feature\]](#)
- New graphical chart allows you to view any of the test results side by side. For example you may wish to view and compare your Brix, SG and Temperature results on a single chart for a specific brew. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Ability to add any bottle size you wish to BrewTrax. We already had the "common" bottle sizes, but you can now add your own. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Manual ABV calculator. BrewTrax already calculates the ABV for any of the brews entered, but this is a handy tool to have for manual calculations. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Scheduler "List View". Allows you to print a complete list of diary entries/reminders so you can plan your brewing actions/events for a given day, week, month etc. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Scheduler "Timeline View". Allows you to view your diary over any period of time, with full details of your reminders. Print it off ready to take into your cellar/brewing area etc. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- 15 new additional fields to log any additions you add to your brew, during the brewing/fermentation process. Several people wanted to log different items such as when Tannin was added, K-Meta, F-Pac etc. As everyone had a slightly different requirement, we have also added the ability to customise and add exactly what fields you want, rather than the software dictate what details you can and can't record. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- New "Maintenance" section allows you to more easily backup & restore your data and locate your backup files. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Ability to change the overall BrewTrax layout. There is now a "Horizontal" or "Vertical" setting which will stack the viewing panels side by side or on top of each other. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Changed the way start, bulk-ageing, bottle ageing/conditioning dates worked; including some improvements to the bottling and completion wizard to make bottling your wines and moving them to the cellar much easier/faster. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- "Add New Recipe" feature occasionally crashed when adding a new brew type. [\[Fixed\]](#)
- Corrections/updates to tool-tips throughout the software. [\[Fixed\]](#)
- Resolved an issue where users with internet connectivity problems could not open the software. [\[Fixed\]](#)
- Resolved a bug where the windows mouse cursor would be displayed after cancelling an appointment in the Scheduler module. [\[Fixed\]](#)
- All SG values that are entered are now padded with a trailing zero. e.g a reading of 1.110 was previously displayed as 1.11 [\[Fixed\]](#)
- Screen sometimes did not refresh whilst in the "Recipes" module. [\[Fixed\]](#)
- "Add New Brew Type" link occasionally failed in "My Brews" module. [\[Fixed\]](#)

- A third tasting sheet/scoring method has been added to the My Tasting Room module. The "Traditional Tasting Sheet" is a comprehensive method of scoring, rating and commenting on your brews. [\[New Feature\]](#)
- Brews are now awarded Gold, Silver, Bronze or Honourable Mention status, based on a percentage score of the tasting session. [\[New Feature\]](#)

- Fixed an issue with the software prompting users to update to the latest version, when no updated version was available. [\[Fixed\]](#)
- Fixed an error in the Scheduler module, where long descriptions were not accepted by the software. This caused the software to crash. Please note, the upgrade will remove any existing schedule descriptions (but will not remove other details such as subject etc.), so you should make a note of current scheduled tasks, as you may need to re-enter these descriptions. - Some users reported AquaLIVE Sync problems. This was due to a database issue on the server and may have presented a number of errors when attempting to login to the software or synchronise with the server. The number of AquaLIVE days remaining may also have displayed incorrectly. [\[Fixed\]](#)
